PARISH COUNCILLOR RESIGNS

PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL BINS

Following numerous requests to East Cambridge District Council after the introduction of wheeled bin services last year to residents, which were restricted to one bin per property for recyclables and one for garden and food waste, the Council's Waste & Environment Sub-Committee has approved the provision of additional bins [*garden waste only*] in return for payment of an annual licence fee.

The licence fee has been announced as £48 per financial year which will to be reviewed annually. An additional bin will be provided which is for *garden waste only*. For further details contact East Cambridge District Council Customer Services on 01353 665555.

DOG WALKERS

There appears to be an increase in dog fouling on pavements and other routes in the village in recent weeks. Dog owners are urged to carry plastic bags with them and clean up after their dogs. We are aware that there are not a great number of dedicated 'Dog bins' in Burwell but there are more than 50 rubbish bins which can be used for this purpose provided plastic bags are used.



DIAL-A-RIDE



This minibus service to Ely, run twice monthly by the Parish Council in partnership with Dial-a-Ride, is open to everyone in the village and costs just £5 return (£2.50 with bus pass). It runs on the first and third Thursdays of each month. To book a place call Dial-a-Ride on 01353 661161.
