### Burwell Speed Watch

A Speed Watch Team has been established in the village. During the group's first week of sessions in mid-August 861 vehicles were monitored, 29 vehicles were recorded as travelling at over the 30 mph speed limit. On a further occasion along Ness Road, within a one hour period, 51 vehicles were travelling above the speed limit. The drivers of all the vehicles travelling above the speed limit will receive a letter from the Police.
