### **BURWELL MASTERPLAN**

The final meeting of the Burwell Masterplan Working Group took place on the 9th of January. With around 40 members of the public present, the group looked at the results of the most recent consultation on the plan and broadly approved the need for 350 new homes on the site next to Newmarket Road with Reach Road sites to be earmarked for business use. However there was concern about the housing figures included in the plan and the Burwell members of the Working Group were to meet with planning officers to address this issue.

A consultation on the Burwell Vision, which will be the plan for Burwell to be included in the East Cambridgeshire District Plan, is scheduled to take place during the week of 11th February. Copies of the Burwell Vision should be delivered to every house in the village for comment. ### **PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS!**

Complaints about the increase in dog fouling have been received by the council. Owners are urged to carry plastic bags with them and clean up after their dogs. We are aware that there are not a great number of dedicated 'Dog bins' in the village but there are more than 50 rubbish bins which can be used for this purpose provided plastic bags are used.

### **LOCAL GRITTING**

After the recent cold snap we are again grateful to the volunteers who have assisted our Parish Council handy men in gritting major pathways in the village. A grit storage bin has been placed at a central location in the village for use by the team.

Gritting of the roads through the village is the responsibility of, and is undertaken, by Cambridgeshire County Council.





## PARISH FINANCES

The Parish Council Finance Working Group recently agreed the budget for 2013-2014, and this will mean that there will be no increase in payments for the third successive year. The working group also updated the Financial Regulations governing financial transactions undertaken by the Parish Council to reflect the recent change to on-line banking.

Building work is to begin this year on the Parish Council office at the Jubilee Reading Room.
