# 04.08.12 Public Forum :-

A parishioner present raised some concerns with regards to overgrown shrubbery along the pathway from Swaffham Road to Station Gate, also an overgrown hedge that was obstructing the pavement along Swaffham Road. The clerk would look into both these matters. She also mentioned that there appeared to be rubbish in the stream in Spring Close and the general area around the stream was untidy. The Clerk would task the handy men to remove the rubbish and speak to the grass cutting contractor with regard to the untidiness along the stream edge.

# 05.08.12 Street Lighting :-

Representatives from the County Council and Balfour Beatty were in attendance to answer questions regarding the new street lighting. The Chairman explained the problems which had been encountered during the changing of the street lighting. Residents and Councillors alike were concerned that there seemed to be no logic to the work schedule, lights were being removed where it was considered they should have been retained and vice versa. One of the biggest issues was the lack of communication and this had been addressed so that other villages should not suffer the same problems. An apology was given to Council for the inconvenience suffered by the village and a promise that they would look at improving the process for the future. The representatives were challenged regarding the ineffective response to complaints and Council were assured that again this would be rectified. Some discussion of specific problems took place and an assurance was given that all queries would be looked at and relevant action taken to remedy problems where possible.

08.08.12 Action Points Update :- **Mandeville Hall** – The Clerk reported that all of the final repairs to the property had been carried out with the exception of the problem with the flooring in the main hall which the contractors had been unable to resolve but would return at a later date.

**Dial-a-Ride** – Following a review of the service it was resolved that unless passenger levels increased on a regular basis it might be necessary to consider terminating the service.

Several approaches had been made to the clerk regarding the possibility of increasing the time in Ely for one of the regular runs to enable users to stay for lunch. Following discussion it was resolved that the Clerk would discuss the possibility with Dial-a-Ride of re-instating the later return journey for one of the runs.

# 10.08.12 County & District Matters :-

**Questionnaire of Play Provision** - It was resolved that the Grounds and Buildings Working Group should meet to complete the questionnaire

**Community Right to Challenge Protocol** – Information has to how to express an interest in biding for the right to supply services had been received from the District Council. This was noted.

Notification of resurfacing work to footways in Orchard Way – Notification had been received that some resurfacing work would be carried out in Orchard Way. It is hoped that work will commence around 3<sup>rd</sup> September but all residents would be notified prior to the commencement of work.

Other issues were then raised and it was resolved that the Clerk would query these issues with the contractor and ask that they are addressed immediately.
